

Headington Parish Hall

The Parish Hall can be hired for a variety of events, including children's parties. The hall is an open and flexible space, approximately 13 x 8 metres, with a wooden floor; it also has a curtained stage and a kitchen. The kitchen has a service area open to the hall if needed. There are separate male and female cloakroom and toilet facilities. A small, carpeted, committee room is also available. Tables and chairs, crockery and cutlery, can be provided.

The hall is now available for daytime bookings during weekdays and weekends and we welcome enquiries.

The cost to hire is from £13 per hour, or less for a regular booking.
